Trusted Traveler Program (TTP) allows temporary visitors to use automated gates, and the scope of its user will expand.

Eligible people are foreign travelers entering Japan for sightseeing, business, visiting relatives, etc.

•To register for TTP, certain requirements must be met (e.g., possession of a passport from a country or region that does not need a visa for visiting Japan).





- Save waiting time at immigration by using the automated gates!
- You can fill out your disembarkation card online in advance!
- Your passport doesn't need to be stamped!
- * An application for registration can be filed online anytime. However, after online application have been verified, the applicant must personally visit designated registration counters in Japan.

Common requirements

Individual requirements

All requirements listed 1 through 5 below must be met.

- Possesses a passport from a country or region that does not need a visa for visits to Japan (*).
- 2. Staying in Japan for a short period for business, sightseeing, visiting relatives, etc.
- 3. Never has been deported or ordered to depart from Japan, or been refused entry.
- 4. Never has been sentenced to a fine or more severe punishment.
- 5. Does not have a status considered to be inappropriate by immigration control.
- * As of January 2020, 68 countries and regions do not need visas to enter Japan.

One of the requirements listed under 1 through 4 (for 1 and 3, either (1) or (2)) below applies.

1. Business person

NEW!

- (1) Director or full-time employee of public or private organizations to which certain requirements apply (regardless of length of employment)
- (2) People whose TTP registration is requested by a Japanese public or private organizations to which certain requirements apply

2. Tourists NEW!

Holders of a credit card (platinum or higher) issued by a company with a license for a global brand who have visited Japan at least once within the 12 months prior.

3. Family members

NEW.

- (1) Spouses of TTP users who are registered as "Business person" or "Tourists"
- (2) Unmarried and under 20-year-old children of TTP users who are registered as "Business person" or "Tourists" (recommended that children be over 12 years old).

4. Japan-U.S. international expedited traveler initiative users (JTTP)

U.S. citizens enrolled in the Global Entry Program (GEP) by U.S. Customs and Border Protection (CBP) who have visited Japan at least once within the 12 months prior.
